Implementation of pay-as-you-throw needs to be backed by regulation, not only of the aspects strictly related to charging (local tax regulations), but also of the main aspects of the waste collection service (municipal ordinances), for example, which waste fractions need to be separated at source and how these need to be delivered to the collection services.

These municipal ordinances must be coherent with the waste charge regulations, and of course they also have to be consistent with regional and national waste regulations. These ordinances also need to include a section on enforcement and penalties.
